Stanford Invitational:

Komosinski, McInvale win races; area runners hold own

The Stanford Invitational is the season's first intrastate benchmark meet, with a number of good out-of-state teams also in the mix.

The San Diego Section, represented by teams from seven schools, came up big.

Torrey Pines junior Julie
Komosinski won the Division I
race in 18:32 over the 3.1-mile
rolling grassy course, and her
teammates placed second in the
race. The winner was a team from
Oregon, making Torrey the top
California team in the race.

The Falcons were helped by good efforts from a trio of sophomores, with Krista Romley (18th), Lauren Jeffers (27th) and Hailey Moore (31st) being key. Jeffers and Moore moved up to the varsity after good efforts at the South Bay Invite a week earlier.

For Torrey, it was another slight closing of the gap between them and the Section's top two teams, Rancho Bernardo and Mt. Carmel.

Komosinski won her race by 0:21 seconds, and her time was the third fastest of the day.

Ramona's McInvale was also in control in winning the Division II race in 15:33. His margin was 0:13 seconds, and his run was the fourth fastest of the day. The Ramona boys, in a mild surprise, were sixth in the competition.


West Hills boys team looked sharp in the Division I race, taking fourth. Oregon teams went one-two, and the state's top-ranked team, Don Lugo, was third, 26 points ahead of the Wolfpack.

Evan Fox led the Pack with a 15:48, and Ben Aragon ran 16:15. Dan Sutton-Kane (16:30) was just 0:15 seconds behind Aragon, and soph Kevin Schible was just 0:10 seconds back of Sutton-Kane. If the Wolfpack continue to tighten up their spacing in the mid-pack, they'll be competitive at the end of the season.


West Hills and Don Lugo hooked up last spring in the Distance Medley relay at the Arcadia Invitational, with the Pack coming from behind to win the race.

Scripps Ranch boys' team was second in the Division II race, behind good efforts from Brendan Riordan, Raphael Machado, Jonathan Hester and Mike Comstock.


St. Augustine's boys team took third in the Division IV race, with

Ryan Moorcroft leading the way. Matt Herriman, Drew Bouchard and Pat Barrett finished in an 0:11 second grouping to help the cause.

The Division I girls team race also saw West Hills (sixth) and Valhalla (seventh) run well. The Division II girls race had University City finish sixth. In team times, those three local schools all put up totals within a 0:15-second range, putting them all on a nearly equal footing, at least based on this race.

San Dieguito Academy's Jenna Timinsky competed as an individual in Division IV, and was third in that race, in 19:12. It was the second fastest time of the day by a San Diego-area runner, trailing only Komosinski.

Dana Hills Invitational:

Vista, Poway boys, Mt. Carmel boys, girls all look sharp

Is any course faster than the Dana Hills speedway?

An internet cross country website described Dana Hills as "the fastest course on the planet."

OK, the times are unreal, but all teams run the same course.

So it was significant that three San Diego boys teams, Vista, Poway and Mt. Carmel, came up with the fastest "team times" of the day in the boys races, and that the Mt. Carmel girls team had the best set of marks in girl racing.

The team times were culled from a series of grade level races, held in three different divisions, over the course of the day.

Vista's five fastest boys averaged 15:02.2, marginally ahead of Poway's average of 15:02.4. Mt. Carmel's boys put up a 15:09.0 average. If this was a preview of what will happen later in the season, the Palomar finals and the CIF finals will be razorclose.

Three other San Diego area boys teams also had team averages of under 16:00 minutes.

Fastest individual times by locals were recorded by the Vista trio of Ryan Montez (14:40), Justin Neuroth (14:42) and Jared Emmons (14:45).

The Mt. Carmel girls put up a truckload of fast times, paced by Janet Mulvey's 17:24 and Deanna Sick's 18:00. Ashlee Dere and Karen Vasko clocked 18:14 and 18:20.

Mt. Carmel coach Dennis McClanahan thought that the course may have been slightly short of the advertised distance of 3 miles.

The Results:

At Dana Hills High School, Saturday, Sept. 25. Races were divided into divisions, and also by grade level. One exception: junior/senior girls ran in one race.

The course is mostly flat, mostly on a hard, fast surface, with the finish situated lower than the starting point. It more closely resembles a fast road race course than a cross country course.



South Bay Invitational:

Pack boys, RB girls win; Valley Center takes two

West Hills' boys and Rancho Bernardo's girls both won the large schools teams races, and Valley Center won both small schools team races at this year's South Bay Invite.

Evan Fox paced the Wolfpack, recording the fastest time of the day, 16:20, over a 3.1-mile course that did not yield fast times.

RB's girls were missing Allison Hall and Jamie Doyle, but they still had enough to hold off Torrey Pines, which had Julie Komosinski put up the fastest girls time of the day, a 14:57 over the 2.47-mile layout.

Valley Center's win in the small school girls race was not a surprise, but their boys team has emerged as a surprisingly strong unit. In winning their team race, they outpointed San Pasqual, St. Augustine and Mar Vista, among others. Most significant was their head-tohead effort against the Saints, which will be their chief rival in the CIF Division IV race next month.

A number of teams were missing key runners in the meet, which negates some of the comparisons experts can usually make from this meet. Also, a few of the lead runners in both small schools varsity races ran offcourse, making their times slower.

In the season's second day, at flat and fast Lindo Lakes, the Vista and Poway boys burned some rubber.


